



Mount Alvernia College Uniforms



The *Formal Uniform* is comprised of formal dress/blouse and pants, hat, tie, day socks (white with dress; grey with pants), and black lace-up leather shoes. The college blazer is compulsory during Terms 2 and 3. The college maroon woollen jumper may be worn for extra warmth. The junior tie is worn by Years 7-11. Year 12 students wear the senior tie. School, house, and name badges are pinned to the tie. The college bag is compulsory; there is a choice of a side (shoulder) bag or backpack, both in black.

The *Sports Uniform* consists of a two-tone polo shirt and grey shorts, a maroon bucket hat with house colour or white cap, anklet socks, and sports shoes. During cooler months, the grey hoodie may be worn over the sports uniform. The spray jacket and track pants may be worn as an alternative to shorts and hoodie. NB: The sports uniform may not be worn to or from school. Students should change from formal uniforms prior to sport activity.



The *Choir Uniform* consists of a red top with scoop neck and short sleeves, worn with black pants and plain black shoes.



The *Netball Uniform* is pictured on the far left. In the centre is the cocurricular shirt, which is worn with college sports shorts/ track pants. To the right, the *Athletics Uniform* consists of the athletics singlet and bike pants, worn alone or under the sports shorts. Athletics uniforms are required for those selected to compete at inter-school or other representative competition.
