UNIFORM BURSARY

The Mount Alvernia College Alumnae Group provides an avenue for past students to keep in contact with former classmates and teachers and to continue their involvement with the College community.

In keeping with the vision and mission of Mount Alvernia College, it is the aim of the Alumnae Group to support and assist past students, or a close family relative (see eligibility conditions) of the Mount Alvernia College community, with financial assistance where able. This assistance is provided in the form of a Uniform Bursary to those experiencing financial difficulties in providing the compulsory uniform items.

Under the terms of the bursary and dependent on the funds available, the Alumnae Group will offer a small number of bursaries each year. The uniform bursary provides assistance to cover the cost of compulsory uniform items to those who meet the eligibility criteria. A uniform voucher (not cash), valid for six (6) months, will be issued which will provide new or used compulsory uniform items from the College Uniform Shop.

Eligibility:

- daughters of a past Mount Alvernian, who is currently enrolled, or whose enrolment has been accepted at Mount Alvernia College
- nieces of past Mount Alvernia College students
- daughters of past Padua College students
- foster children of any of the above
- others may be considered (please specify relationship)
- a family who is experiencing financial difficulties in providing the compulsory uniform items required for college activities

What the Scholarship covers:

Uniform Bursary for the purchase of compulsory uniform items. The following items may be purchased: *blazer, formal hat, dress, tie, bucket hat, sports shirt, sports shorts, school bag, jumper and socks*. Requests for partial assistance towards individual compulsory uniform items will also be considered.

How to apply:

- Application forms are available from the Uniform Shop, school website or office
- Applications are to be submitted to the office marked *CONFIDENTIAL* to the Principal

Approval of Bursary:

- Strict privacy will be maintained at all times
- Decisions will be made by the Principal. No personal details will be disclosed beyond the Principal.
- Formal notification of bursary success or otherwise, will be provided as soon as possible after the application has been received
- Valid for six (6) months from date of issue
