Conditions of Enrolment

- Enrolment will only be accepted on the understanding that all fees are paid by direct debit with invoices being paid in full by 30th October each year. The Direct Debit form is attached. Contact the FCIP Secretary should you require assistance.
- School fees should be current for a student to participate in FCIP ensembles
- Students cannot cease lessons during a term
- If tuition is to be discontinued, written notice must be received by the College at least 4 weeks prior to the end of Term or a full Term's fees will be charged
- It is the responsibility of students to ensure they attend all timetabled lessons and rehearsals
- Members of FCIP ensembles are committed to performing for the Franciscan Colleges when required
- As with the Padua and Mt Alvernia sporting teams Policy, attendance at FCIP performances takes precedence over out-of-school activities. Special staff exemption must be sought within a reasonable time.
