



Overseas Study Scholarships

Graduates of Mount Alvernia College wishing to study overseas are invited to apply for an Overseas Study Scholarship (OSS).

The OSS is funded by the Mount Alvernia Parents and Friends Support Network (P&FSN), and is available for past students for undergraduate and postgraduate study overseas, for periods of six or twelve months. Current Year 12 students who have organised overseas study for the following year may also apply.

Preference will be given to students studying at an overseas tertiary institution/university for one or more semesters. Applicants studying overseas at tertiary institutions other than universities (eg apprentice chef) are also welcome to apply.

The level of funding for each successful candidate is at the discretion of the panel, consisting of the Mount Alvernia College Principal and a representative of the P&FSN. There will be no negotiation with applicants as to the quantum of the scholarship.

Applications for study commencing in the first semester of 2020 or the second semester of 2020 close on Friday 1 November 2019.
